

GBC Council Minutes

February 27, 2018

1. GBC President Allie welcomed the executive council. She pointed out that the full council is meeting after a gap because of election pitches and reading week. She informed the Council that the incoming executive will be present for the next meeting.
2. Case Competitions Director Grishma informed the Council that the next round of Deans Cup will be taking place on 3-4 March.
3. GBC VP Levin explained that the Council elections have to be postponed by 5 days because of processing issues with YorkU. The person concerned went on leave and did not pass the file to any one on York Elections team. Elections are now scheduled for Friday and Saturday, 2-3 March. New voting website: yuvote.yorku.ca. The election committee will remind the student body on all platforms as the election draws near. The new council will be announced at a special council meeting next Monday, 5 March at 5.45 pm. There will be no Council meeting on Tuesday because of an Alumni related event that requires the presence of the GBC executive council.
4. Communications Director Yogendra Kalavalapalli informed the Council that environment-friendly Yearbooks are now on sale. Yearbook 2018 costs \$32 while a combo of Yearbook 2017 and 2018 costs \$42. Students were also invited to share photographs on Google Drive via link shared on Facebook page.
5. Social affairs director TJ Panth informed the Council that Gala tickets are now on sale. 99\$ early bird prices until 31 March. Only one guest allowed per person to enable maximum number of students to participate. The gala will be held at a new location this year in Vaughan. This is more incentive for students to come. Allie also reminded the Council that the Gala serves as the unofficial transfer for the new GBC Executive. GBC advises students not to drink and drive. Free parking is available at the venue and there are 2 hotels close by for any one who wants to stay over night.
